Your package

All delegates must book through the one source or agent. P&O Cruises will not accept group bookings that come via multiple channels. Allocated rooms are blocked in double occupancy basis only. Triples and quads are capacity controlled and are subject to availability. The number of children accepted onboard is also restricted and subject to inventory control. Whilst the allotment guarantees selected grades, it does not guarantee specific rooms. Once rooms are assigned, they may be changed due to operational reasons.

P&O CORPORATE

How do I plan for my event?

Our experienced Event Coordinators will help you plan everything you need for your event, from selecting your cruise to finalising your event details. A good starting point is to select your cruise preference (date and departure port). To find your perfect cruise, refer to the "find a cruise" search engine at pocruises.com.au

How many guests can be part of the group?

Each ship has a range of venues to accommodate different-sized groups. If you're planning an event, a minimum of 16 guests is required.

Will I get better rates for booking as a group?

We can offer a discounted rate on selected cruises for groups of 16 or more guests. In addition, for every 16 guests (8 twin rooms) a cash reward will be offered.

What is a cash reward and how does it work?

The value of one cash reward is equivalent to the fare of one guest based on the average value of the room category booked (excluding government fees and taxes).

How is the cash reward calculated and refunded?

The cash reward is calculated within 2 weeks after your cruise. We will send your cash reward cheque via the post at this time. The average fare from all bookings will be calculated, and that sum reimbursed to the primary group contact via cheque, excluding all taxes, government fees and charges. As the cash reward is calculated after your cruise, we are unable to let you know in advance what the final cash reward refund will be.

What if the group numbers reduce prior to cruising?
